

STUDENT ACTIVITY AWARD POLICY Revised 9/16/16

Activity Awards are funds dedicated to support student learning and mastery of specific skills through the student's participation in a curricular, co-curricular or extra-curricular activity that are connected to the students program of study.

- The skills and education supported by the activity award should not be incidental but central to academic experience, degree progress and successful degree completion.
- The benefit of the supported activity must be primarily for the student receiving the award and not for the program, department, or university.
- When possible, it is recommended that the activity award is tied to credit hour coursework.
- It is most appropriate if the student's major is associated with the activity.

Students and Faculty must complete the CFPCA Activity Checklist to determine if the activity qualifies for an Activity Award. The CFPCA Activity Award Application and Acknowledgement is then completed for processing the award.

Eligibility for Student Activity Awards requires the recipient to be:

- 1) Registered for classes in the current or following term at WSU.
- 2) In good academic standing within the University.

NOTE: Eligibility is determined by the Chair or his or her designee and the Dean's Office
